



Code of Conduct at Casa Slovacca / Galleria Meravigli

General Guidelines for Visitors to the Indoor Areas of Galleria Meravigli

1. Respect the Cultural and Historical Value of the Venue

- Galleria Meravigli is a protected historical site – please treat its architecture, artistic elements, and furnishings with respect.
- Do not touch decorations, columns, windows, glass doors, or curtains.
- Any damage to or soiling of the premises will be considered a violation of the visitor regulations.

2. Follow Staff Instructions

- Always comply with the instructions of event organizers, hostesses, security personnel, or technical staff.
- In case of an emergency, follow staff instructions or leave the premises via the nearest emergency exit.

3. Maintain Order and Cleanliness

- Dispose of waste, packaging, and beverages only in designated bins.
- If you spill or damage anything, please report the incident to staff immediately.

4. Dress Code and Conduct

- Appropriate and respectful attire corresponding to the nature of the event is recommended.
- Inappropriate behavior, excessive noise, vulgar language, excessive alcohol consumption, or any form of discrimination towards other visitors is not permitted.
- In the event of inappropriate behavior, the organizer reserves the right to request the individual to leave the premises.

5. Safety and Movement Within the Premises

- Do not block walkways or emergency exits.
- Stay within marked routes and respect restricted areas.
- Running, climbing on railings, columns, structures, installations, or accessing the stage without authorization is prohibited.

6. Photography and Filming

- During Olympic events, all rules related to media rights ownership and brand protection of Milano Cortina 2026 must be respected.

- The use of flash, tripods, and other professional equipment may be prohibited.
- In areas with historical interiors, follow any photography restrictions or instructions provided by on-site staff.

7. Protection of Property and Personal Belongings

- Visitors are responsible for their own personal belongings.
- Neither the organizer nor the gallery management is liable for loss or theft of items within the gallery/Casa Slovacca premises.
- Large bags and luggage must be deposited in the cloakroom. The operator is responsible for the deposited item (e.g. bag or suitcase) as a whole, but not for valuables, cash, or other valuable items inside unless they have been expressly declared and accepted for safekeeping.

8. Respect Other Visitors

- Please silence or switch mobile phones to silent mode during events.
- Respect the personal space of other visitors and performers.

9. Children and Supervision

- Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.

10. Prohibitions and Restrictions

- Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is strictly prohibited.
- Animals are not permitted, except for assistance dogs.
- The use of open flames, pyrotechnics, or other hazardous substances is prohibited.
- Visitors are not allowed to consume food or beverages purchased outside the gallery premises.

11. Liability and Consequences

- In the event of damage to the gallery's property, equipment, or the organizer's installations, the visitor will be required to compensate the full value of the damage.
- The organizer reserves the right to amend or supplement these rules depending on the type of event.

12. Final Provisions

- By entering the premises, visitors agree to these rules and undertake to comply with them.
- Violation of these rules may result in immediate removal from the premises.
